




# Technical Coordinator

## Role Purpose:

To manage the team's technical assets and ensure drivers have the necessary tools and environments to perform. They make sure drivers have everything they need to be fast and ready: the right setups, quality practice time, solid coaching, and quick fixes when tech goes wrong. They are not doing every setup tweak or running every coaching session themselves –they're orchestrating the people and systems that help our drivers become faster and more prepared.

## Key Responsibilities:

- **Setup Curation and Management:** Organizes and distributes car setups, ensuring files are version-controlled and easy to find. Manages Race Engineers and ensures the correct setups are being prioritised based on race team needs.
- **Practice Server Management:** Responsible for the setup and running of practice servers, including the goals for the sessions. Ensures all members are practicing with the current settings and conditions.
- **Technical Guidance:** Responsible for the gathering/creation of troubleshooting guides for software and hardware issues and ensuring the team has easy access to them.
- **Driver Coaching Management:** Manage our driver coaches and ensure that race engineers and coaches are working towards the same goals.

## **Reporting & Collaboration:**

- Reports to the Sporting Director
- Collaborates with the Race Event Coordinator, to understand the events to prioritise setup, practice and coaching for.

## **Supervises/Manages:**

- Race Engineers (Setup creators)
- Driver Coaches
- Technical Support Staff (Creators for support guides / troubleshooting tips)
